POST Rules & Statutes: What Every CLEO Needs to Know

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Although the POST Board has been in existence since 1978 and has the potential to end the career of every licensed peace officer in Minnesota, surprisingly few license holders and Chief Law Enforcement Officers (CLEO) have spent much time really understanding the statutes and rules that POST operates under. In this day long class we are going to take a deep dive with the POST Board's very first lawyer and one who still serves on a POST rule advisory committee. MSA attorney Rick Hodsdon is going to explore with you a brief history of POST, the statutes and rules it operates under, including the rules enacted in June, 2023, and recent statutory changes that represent the most significant changes and expansion of POST authority in over 40 years. If you are a licensed peace officer, and especially if you are a CLEO who has responsibility and liability for your not only your own license but every licensee in your agency, here is your chance to learn from an instructor with a truly unique perspective about POST
