This is a 32-hour course of lecture and hands-on instruction. The course will provide participants with knowledge, skills and confidence to professionally and properly control a resistive, combative subject. The course will cover legal and liability issues, how stress affects the body, and how to navigate through a use of force continuum. The course will also cover hand cuffing and other restraints found in corrections. Defensive tactics, Pressure points, Stuns and distractions, blocks, escapes, control techniques or escorts, Takedowns, ground survival skills, team control techniques, and edge weapons defense techniques will also be covered. This course was put together by use of force experts and instructors with over 40 years of experience and reviewed by an attorney at the Minnesota Counties Insurance Trust. This course also has a large focus on instructor development and how to instruct this material.
